

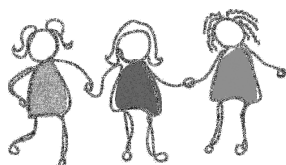
Safety Always Comes First

Remember to follow all Safety-Wise procedures.

- Do not collect money until cookies are delivered.
- Girl Scouts 13 years and older may promote cookies sales using the internet, including Web sites chat rooms, Twitter, Facebook or a broadcast e-mails to solicit sales. However they must read and sign the internet safety pledge and obtain parent permission before using the internet to promote their cookie sales. There will not be any form of taking payment for cookies purchased permitted online such as using PayPal.
- Girl Scouts Daisies sell only to people they know and only participate in booth sales with close adult supervision. They can use the telephone with a grownup's permission.

Selling in Your Neighborhood

- Girls should always wear their Girl Scout membership pin with their uniform, sash, or vest, or Girl Scout T-shirt.
- Girls must be familiar with the neighborhoods where they sell.
- Sell door-to-door only during daylight hours.
- Brownie and Junior Girl Scouts must be accompanied by an adult when selling and delivering cookies.
- Girls 11-17 must be supervised by an adult when selling cookies door-to-door.
- Girls should never enter a customer's house.
- Girls must sell with a buddy.
- Girls should never approach customers in cars.



Booth Sales

- Adults must be present at all times when Girl Scouts operate a booth in a store, mall or any other public place.
- Girls should never give out their names, addresses or telephone numbers to customers. The adult Cookie Manager's telephone number can be provided.

Money Management

- Do not collect money until cookies are delivered.
- Girls must have a plan for safeguarding the money they collect.
- Girls should not carry around large amounts of cash.
- Money may be given to the accompanying or supervising adult.
- **It is up to each individual troop whether or not to accept checks. It is the responsibility of the troop to handle NSF checks. The bank charges for NSF checks is \$30. We recommend not taking checks for more than \$50.**

We highly encourage those Daisy Troops who choose to participate in the sale to have the girls sell only to family and friends to practice their skills. Also this means participating Daisy Troops must start a bank account. Please ask the Council for details.
