Position Title: Unit Leader for Teddy Bear Camp

Position Summary

The Unit Leader is responsible for the health, welfare, and development of campers and for planning, preparing, implementing all Teddy Bear camp activities. This position is solely for the 2-night, 3 day Teddy Bear camp.

Qualifications:

- Experience working with children.
- Maturity, good judgment, and ability to deal with emergency situations.
- Must have excellent communication and organizational skills.
- Willing to work as a team member.
- Flexibility, energy, and good sense of humor.
- Outdoor/camping skills and experience.
- Interest in and knowledge of Girl Scout program and Safety-Wise.
- Basic swimming ability.
- Minimum age: 18 years old.
- Valid driver's license and clean driving record.

Key Responsibilities:

- Attend and participate in pre-camp training.
- Coordinate, lead, and supervise all camp programs for assigned unit based on camp daily schedule.
- Encourage safe and minimal impact camping skills and activities.
- Support and participate in all camp activities.
- Support campers in having fun and adventure while learning new skills.
- Be responsible for camper location and implement buddy system.
- Supervise the campers in unit housekeeping, sanitation, care of supplies, and equipment and cabin inspections.
- Follow all camp policies.
- Be a positive role model for girls.
- Willingness to perform all other duties as assigned by supervisor.
