Position Title: Waterfront/ Boating Director

Accountable to: Assistant Camp Director

Term: July 12- August 1, 2010*

Salary: \$500/ week x 3 weeks = \$1,500

Position Summary

The Waterfront/ Boating Director is accountable for the organization and administration of safe waterfront activities.

Qualifications:

- Ability to teach, train, and supervise safe waterfront activities.
- Must demonstrate maturity and sound decision-making and problem-solving skills.
- Exceptional communication and organizational skills.
- Experience working with children.
- Current certification as American Red Cross Lifeguard or CPR for professional rescuer (CPRO) and Water Safety Instructor (WSI).
- Must be honest, friendly, and flexible.
- Valid driver's license and clean driving record.
- Show health examination including TB test.
- Preferred age: 21 years or older.

Key Responsibilities:

- Attend and participate in pre-camp training.
- Develop and carry out waterfront program.
- Provide instruction in watercraft and water safety.
- Schedule waterfront area use.
- Responsible to handle waterfront emergencies.
- Monitor equipment and watercraft regularly for safety.
- Conduct staff swim tests.
- Assist with meal and bedtime activities and other camp activities when needed.
- Willingness to perform all other duties as assigned by supervisor.
